SUBJECT: **DOWNLOADING OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM
OPERATING EXPENSES FOR SY 2024-2025**

1. Pursuant to OM-OUOPS Memorandum No. 2023-09-4944 re: Fifth Advisory for the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) SY 2024-2025 and DepEd Order No. 31, s. 2021 (Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program), this Office hereby informs the field of the list of SBFP recipient schools with its corresponding number of beneficiaries and budget allocation for operational expenses (P3.00 for NFP and P1.00 for milk), please see Enclosure No. 1.
2. All 68 Elementary Schools are directed to submit the SBFP supporting documents, to wit:
 - a. Letter Request for Cash Advance
 - b. Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP)
 - c. Work and Financial Plan (WFP)
 - d. Annual Procurement Plan (APP)
3. Submission of the SBFP supporting documents shall be in **hard copies** (one copy for each document) to School Health Section attention: **MARIA SARLINE R. OPENIANO-FLORES, Medical Officer III**, on or before **August 9, 2024**.
4. Moreover, the SBFP- Nutritious Food Products for SY 2023-2024 will have a total of 175 feeding days (160 feeding days during regular school days with an additional 15 days for National Learning Camp (NLC) in Calendar Year (CY) 2025, while the SBFP- Milk Feeding component for SY 2024-2025 will have a total of 44 feeding days.
